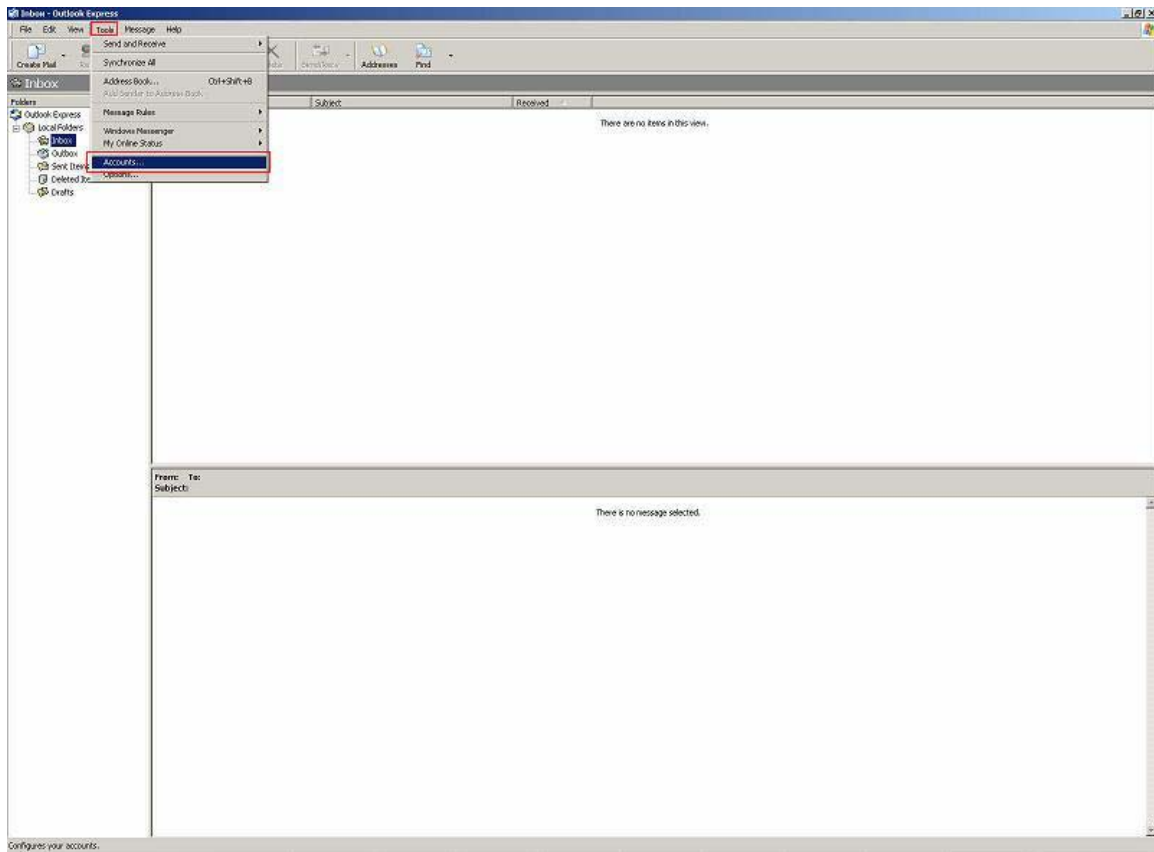



Step 1: Open Outlook Express and go to the Tools menu and select E-Mail Accounts






Step 4: Configure the E-mail Internet Connection and select "Next"

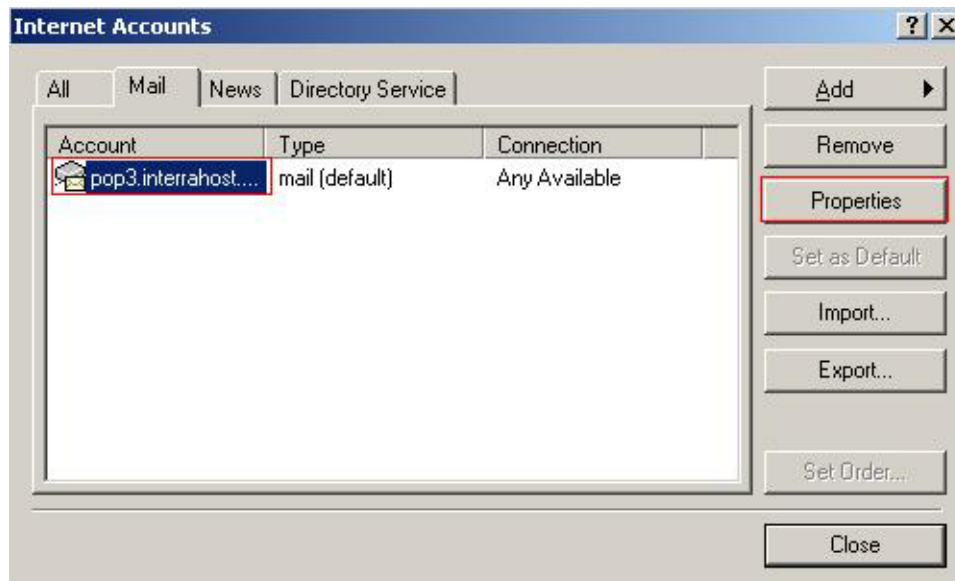

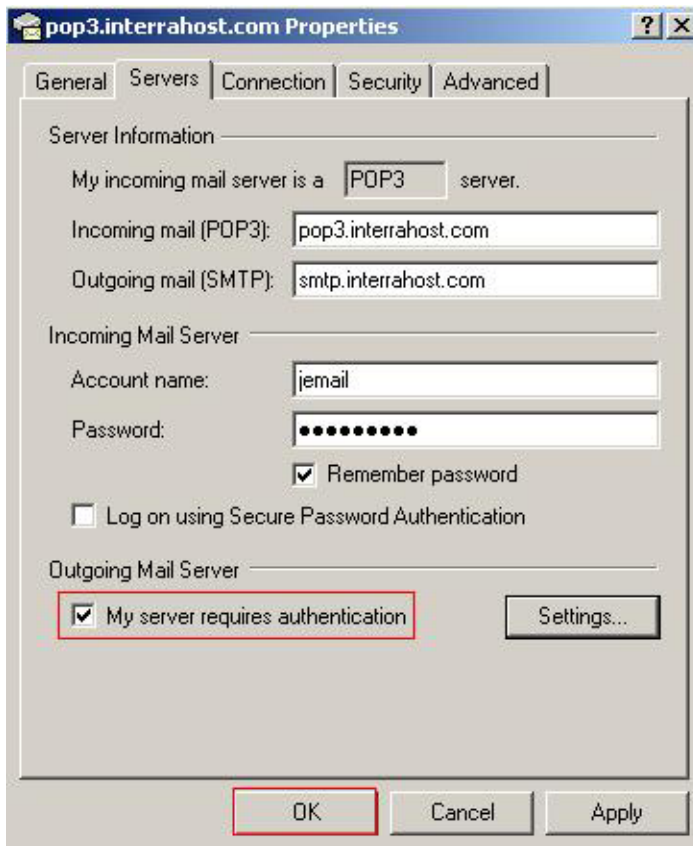
Step 6: Select "Finish"
